# Dream Team Honor Code

As an essential member of the Church of the King Dream Team, you have a leadership responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behavior. This should be the basic premise of your desire to serve on the Dream Team at Church of the King.

While serving the Body of Christ as a Dream Team member at Church of the King, you pledge to present a good appearance at all times. In both attire and behavior, you should strive to demonstrate biblical standards in all situations.

As Christians, the way we present ourselves to others is of vital importance to the way others perceive Christ; therefore, our conduct should never be an embarrassment to Christ but rather exemplify the best qualities of a mature believer and follower of Christ.

Exemplifying the highest moral commitment, Church of the King's Dream Team leaders and members are to maintain a disciplined life of Bible reading, prayer, and fasting. Additionally, as a Dream Team member, you must also refrain from such things as:

- profanity
- harmful gambling habits
- exploitation of the relational network of Church of the King through any business practices, including multi-level marketing, for personal financial gain
- alcohol consumption or use of tobacco related products in a manner that may impair your Christian witness
- unethical practices
- illegal drugs
- pornography
- sexual immorality (including adultery, homosexual acts, and other sexual activity outside of a biblical marriage)
- all behaviors which might cause Christ to grieve and others to stumble

By providing an example in speech and action, we encourage others to grow in Christ and become servant leaders themselves. Being a member of the Dream Team is a way of life measured by the heart commitment of each Dream Team leader and member in the Church of the King spiritual family. As such, we should regard our Dream Team service as an essential part of our spiritual development as believers in Christ. ### Leadership Qualification

The same goes for those who want to be servants in the church: serious, not deceitful, not too free with the bottle, not in it for what they can get out of it.
