This month's discussion is about one of our TEAM values and convictions here at Church of the King, serving with excellence. We want to be servant leaders who pursue excellence in everything. The overarching reasons of why we serve with excellence are that "Excellence inspires people and honors God."

In order to understand the meaning of excellence, we must distinguish between what it is and what it is not.

Serving with Excellence <u>IS NOT</u>: Doing things to make ourselves look good, having an "it's good enough" mindset, and being a perfectionist. Sometimes people mistake excellence for perfection.

What IS serving with excellence? Serving with excellence is doing the best we can with our time, talent, and treasure to meet the needs of the people God has placed in our proximity. For example, Daniel gave his best as he honored God while serving others.

"Then this Daniel became distinguished above all the others high officials and satraps, because an EXCELLENT SPIRIT was in him. And the King planned to set him over the whole kingdom." Daniel 6:3

For the remainder of our discussion we will look at two reasons as to why we serve people with excellence.

We serve with excellence because:

1. People matter

"You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:39

2. God is excellent

"We are ambassadors of the Anointed One who carry the message of Christ to the world, as though God were tenderly pleading[b] with them directly through our lips." 2 Corinthians 5:20

We honor people because God honors people! Serving people with excellence creates an opportunity for people to experience God's love and can diffuse lies, confusion, fear, anxiety, etc.
